AUT Library

#### **Requesting Library Resources**

Undergraduate students can borrow books for **24 days.** You can renew books up to 3 times it if hasn't been requested by another Library user. You can request up to 20 items at one time.

Postgraduate student can borrow books for **31 days**.. You can renew a book up to 6 times if it hasn't been requested by another Library user. You can request up to 50 items at one times.

How to request items:

There are 3 ways to request items for Distance students:

- Search for an item through Library Search. Click on 'See all results'. Under the item title, click 'Request this item'. Select the 'Distance' option in the dropdown list under 'Pickup Location'. Click on 'Submit request'.
- Submit a request for an article or book chapter through this <u>online form</u> on the Library website.
- Email your request to: distlib@aut.ac.nz .

Books will be couriered to your address with a prepaid return bag. Recalled items must be returned within 7 days of the recall date. If you have any questions about recalls, contact the <u>Resource Sharing team</u>.

#### Interloan services

This is a freeservice.

AUT staff and students are eligible to borrow in person, from any other member university under the ULANZ national borrowing scheme (all New Zealand universities are ULANZ members except the University of Auckland).

If an item is not held by the AUT Library, then AUT staff and students can request it through the Interlibrary Loan system. See <u>this guide</u> on the Library website.

#### Information & Research Services

- Have exceptional circumstances who are deemed eligible by the Faculty they are enrolled in.
